Dear Parents,

We are excited to announce that as part of our science topic, 'Animals Including Humans,' Year 1 will be embarking on a trip to Askham Bryan on Tuesday 24th June 2025. This is a fantastic opportunity for the children to take part in a workshop provided by the knowledgeable staff at Askham Bryan, where they will explore the wildlife and various habitats.

We plan to leave school at approximately 9:00 am, so please ensure your child arrives on time. For those who usually have school dinners, a packed lunch will be provided. For children who normally bring their own lunch, please do so as usual. All children will need a suitable bag to carry their lunch and water bottle— a backpack will work perfectly. It is also important that children wear their school uniform, but we ask that they wear sensible walking shoes, as we will be on our feet for most of the day.

Given the nature of the trip, please make sure your child is dressed appropriately for the weather. This may mean packing a sun hat and sunglasses or a raincoat, depending on the forecast. We also advise applying sun cream before arriving at school.
