Cricket North Yorkshire 2025

We are very excited to share with you that we will be participating in the North Yorkshire Cricket Tournament this year.

Our first event will be the qualifiers which is due to take place on Thursday 5th June 2025, 9.15-2.30pm at Harrogate Cricket Club for the Year 3/4 pupils, both the girls and boys' competition will take place on the same day.

If we are successful, the finals will be held on 10th June for the boy's team and 11th June for the girls. More details will follow if we secure a place.

Teams will play 8-a-side Dynamos format cricket. We are hoping to take a boys' team of 8 pupils and a girls' team of 8 pupils to the event. Yorkshire cricket have shared that they would like us to bring a mixed team of both experienced and new to cricket players. There is certainly a heavy participation (rather than performance) focus.

Please state on the email if your child is experienced in playing cricket or new to the sport. I will then draw names out of a hat and let you know the outcome via email on the same day.
