We have been practising subitising and can say if we can see 3 or not 3 just by just looking at them. The children were so good at subitising that we practised drawing around the amount we noticed when we dropped nuts and bolts onto a table. We can't count when subitising so we really have to use our noticing skills. We have been making tallies to represent numbers and can say how many a tally shows. We've had some more exciting adventures to Number Land and have been making number land 0-10 and then creating Number Land for numbers 0-3.

In phonics we have enjoyed learning new listening games like 'Jack in the box.' We have been enjoying changing the words of well known nursery rhymes. We have also enjoyed creating our own imaginative stories using the Tales Toolkit symbols.















