I am writing to inform you of an upcoming change to the charges for Nursery, The Hive, and School Lunches, which will take effect from **1st September 2025**.

This decision has not been made lightly. However, due to significant and sustained increases in key areas—such as the National Minimum Wage, National Insurance contributions, and the rising costs of food, energy, and materials—we are left with no choice but to revise our pricing. These changes are essential to ensure that we can continue delivering the high-quality care and services your children deserve.
