Summer 1: Planet Protectors
Summer 2: The Norman Conquest



Overview of the topic for the summer term

Planet Protectors: This half term our topic will be Planet Protectors. We will explore how humans impact the environment and learn about ways we can help to protect our planet. The children will investigate important issues such as pollution, waste, climate change and the importance of caring for wildlife and natural habitats. We will also look at practical ways we can make a difference in our daily lives, including recycling, reducing waste and saving energy. Throughout the topic, pupils will develop their understanding of how small actions can help protect the Earth for future generations.

The Norman Conquest: This half term our history topic will be the Norman Conquest. We will explore the events leading up to the Battle of Hastings in 1066 and learn about the key figures involved, including King Harold and William the Conqueror. The children will investigate why William invaded England and how the Norman victory changed the country. Throughout the topic we will examine how the Normans took control of England, including the building of castles and changes to everyday life. Pupils will use a range of historical sources to help them understand what life was like during this important period in British history.
