### Welcome back to the nursery!

Welcome back to all of our nursery families – we hope you had a lovely Easter break. This term the children will be learning about The Great Outdoors. This will cover minibeasts, farms, zoos and noticing the signs of summer. We will be looking at what it takes to be explorers when we are camping and hearing about our own camping experiences.

We are going to make the most of the better weather and take a lot of our learning outside where we will enjoy building obstacle courses, mark making with chunky chalks and making potions in the mud kitchen.

This term we will continue to strengthen children's fine motor skills with lots of funky finger activities such as threading, dough disco, flipper flappers etc ready for the children starting pre-school.

We will be looking at building on the children's independence and will be encouraging the children to put on their own coats and begin to wipe their own bottoms (that can then be checked by an adult).
