



Pension Credit

Pension Credit can top up your pension when you have reached state pension age and there are lots of people who qualify but who are not claiming. It is worth checking if you are eligible as the Winter Fuel Payment is now means tested and to qualify you need to be of state pension age, born before the qualifying date and be in receipt of Pension Credit, Universal Credit or some other means-tested benefits.

If you qualify for Pension Credit you may also qualify for other help, including help with NHS costs, Housing Benefit (if you rent), reduced council tax, cold weather payments and Warm Home Discount.

Maximising your income

Make sure that you are in receipt of all the benefits that you are entitled to. You can use the turn2us online checker www.benefits-calculator.turn2us.org.uk

If you are not sure who to turn to you can call the North Yorkshire Council customer service centre on 0300 131 2 131, Mon to Fri 9.30am – 4.30pm and ask for 'cost of living support'.

How can I manage my energy bills?

Give regular monthly meter readings, this will ensure you receive accurate, not estimated bills. Check your bills and that your smart meter is sending readings to your supplier. If you are in debt speak to your supplier ASAP. If you can, increase your direct debit or ask your supplier if they have a Trust Fund that can help clearing energy debts.

The most expensive way to pay for energy is to pay when the bill comes. You could save an average of £112 per year by switching to a direct debit. If you have a pre-payment meter and don't have any debt on them, British Gas, E.ON, Next, EDF and SSE and Scottish Power will now exchange for a credit meter free of charge, but they will run a credit check first.
