



Western Primary School Uniform Policy

At Western Primary School, we expect all children to wear the school uniform, promoting a sense of pride, equality, and belonging. Parents and carers are asked to ensure that their child arrives at school in the correct uniform each day.

School Uniform

Children are expected to wear the following uniform:

- Red sweatshirt, hoodie, or cardigan (Western logo optional)
- White or red polo shirt
- Grey or black trousers, skirts, or pinafores
- Grey or black shorts (not sport or cycle shorts) or summer dresses (white and red checks) may be worn in the summer months
- Sensible black shoes or plain black supportive trainers (no platforms or high heels)
- No accessories that may be deemed a health and safety risk, including jewellery (ear studs are permitted where necessary)

Physical Education (PE) Uniform

For PE, children should wear:

- Years 1–6: a top with the Western school logo in their House colour, or a plain white t-shirt. Reception children should wear a plain white t-shirt.
- Plain black tracksuit bottoms, shorts, leggings, skirt, or skort
- Plain white socks
- Trainers suitable for physical activity, or black pumps for indoor PE
- Strictly no jewellery, including watches and ear studs (these should not be worn on PE days where possible)

Additional Guidance

- Thermal base layers, school jumpers, and coats are permissible and recommended in colder weather.
- Children should always bring a waterproof jacket to school.
- Please ensure all uniform is clearly labelled with your child's name.

This policy helps ensure that all children are dressed appropriately for school life, keeping them safe, comfortable, and ready to learn.
