Volcanoes and Earthquakes

Overview of the topic

This is a history based topic in which the children will explore the world of the Ancient Greeks. They will begin by finding out about the geography of Greece and will learn how the Ancient Greek period fits in with other periods of history they have learned about. They will compare and contrast life in Sparta to life in Athens and find out about some of the things we still do today that we learned from the Ancient Greeks. Watch out for details of our Ancient Greek Day where Holden will be invited to dress up and take part in an Ancient Greek Olympics!

In English we will be reading Tales of the Trojan War and writing our own Greek myths along with many other genres of writing.

Our art unit is textile based and the children will be practising their sewing skills. In science, we will complete our forces unit and then move onto Life Processes and Living Things.
