As part of our History topic on The Great Fire of London, we are excited to be taking part in an online, interactive drama workshop on **the date above**. This engaging workshop will bring our learning to life and help the children explore our key enquiry question: "Would the Great Fire of London happen now?"

The workshop will be delivered by a specialist drama company and will allow the children to take part in storytelling, role play and interactive activities to deepen their understanding of this important historical event.

As a drama-led experience, the company encourages all taking part to dress up to enhance the fun and immersion. We would love the children to dress up if they feel comfortable doing so. This could be as simple as wearing clothing inspired by the 1660s (such as a shirt, apron, shawl, waistcoat or dress), or even just darker, older-style clothing. There is absolutely no expectation to buy anything new - simple, creative ideas from home are perfect.

To help cover the cost of the workshop, we are asking for a voluntary contribution of **£4 per child**, which is payable via Arbor under School Trips. In the event that a parent is unable to contribute, his/her child will not be treated any differently.

If the school receives insufficient voluntary contributions, the workshop may be cancelled. To ensure we do not incur any cancellation costs, we are asking that contributions be made by **Monday 23rd March**.
