

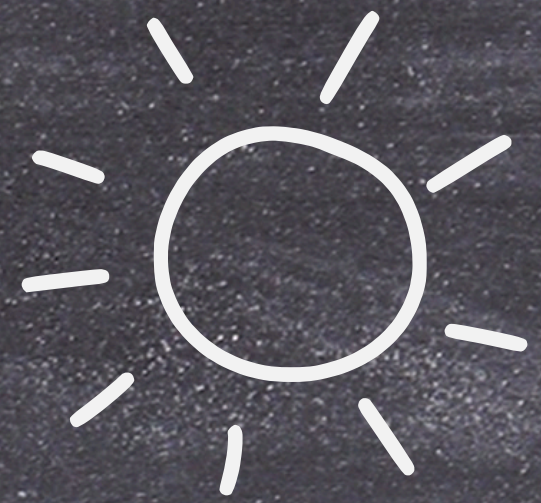
RECEPTION OUR LEARNING SUMMER 1 WEEK 5

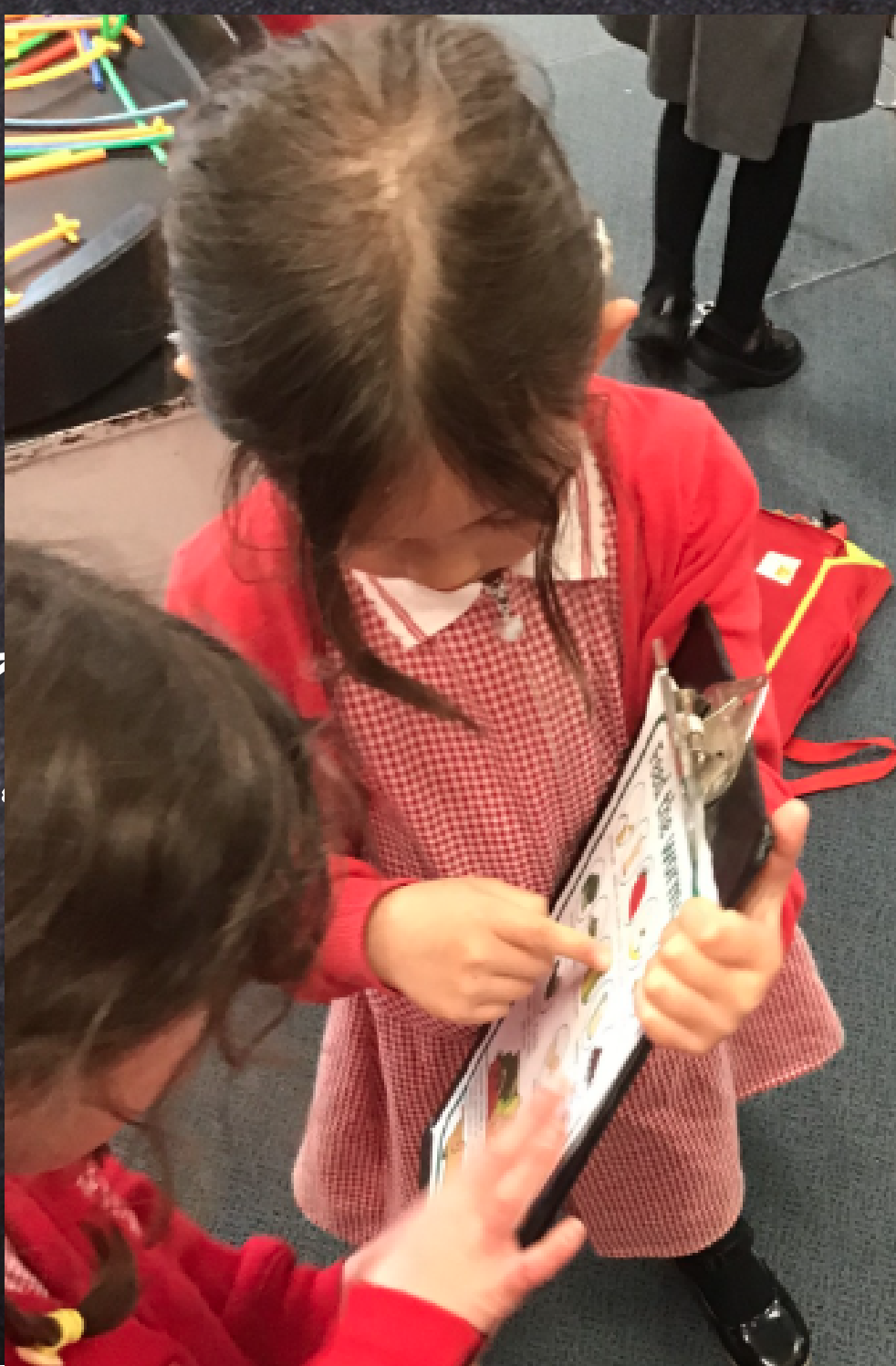
We have had lots of fun outside in the clay tuff tray; we have been strengthening our hand muscles to help promote our fine motor skills.

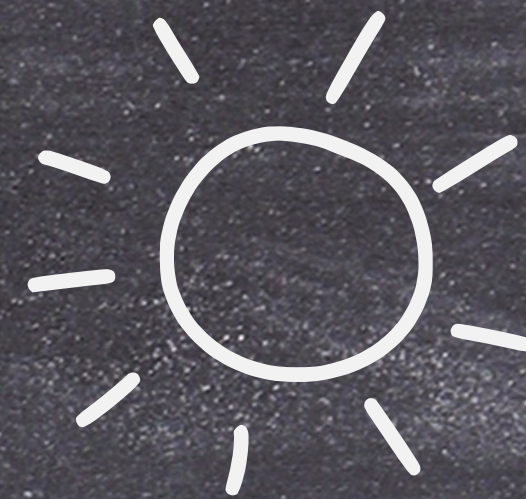
