

## Swimming 2023-2024

Dear Parents/ Carers,

At Western, we are committed to providing a rich and balanced curriculum that provides children with a wealth of opportunities. As set out in the National Curriculum, all schools must provide swimming instruction either in Key Stage 1 or Key Stage 2. By the end of Year 6, pupils should be taught to:

- Swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres
- Use a range of strokes effectively [for example, front crawl, backstroke and breaststroke]
- Perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations

As a school, we are constantly adapting and changing in response to the needs of the children. To ensure a balanced curriculum with equal opportunities for all, we are moving to a new model aiming to embed the swimming curriculum across phases. This will enable a swimming experience that considers the developing maturity of all children.

Water safety and swimming are vital life skills and will be viewed as progressive throughout a child's journey at Western. Moving forward, we will begin our offer of swimming provision in Y2 for a term, progressing to a second term when the children reach Y4 and a final term when they reach Y5. By the end of Y6, a single cohort will have taken part in a maximum total of 38 swimming sessions to meet the National Curriculum criteria.

We appreciate that the children moving into Y4 in September will have had most of their sessions when they were in Y2. Much like we revisit, consolidate and embed all other aspects of our curriculum for teaching and learning, we believe that additional swimming experiences for our older children will offer a continuation of their physical development.
