Dear Parents/Carers,

On **Friday 21**st **June** (a change of date) we plan to hold our annual Sports Day event on the Stray. The children will need to wear their P.E. kit to school on this day. As with most events, this will be dependent on the weather as we will need dry ground to complete the activities.

The event will take place on the Stray alongside Beech Road. We plan to leave school at 9.15 a.m., complete our sports activities and return to school at approximately 11.00 a.m.

We will require lots of helpers if this trip will go ahead as our staff will be involved in running the activities.

The statutory framework for the EYFS states that: Children must must be kept safe on outings The assessment must include consideration of adult-to-child ratios

It is therefore good practice to increase the child:adult ratio for all trips and outings to a greater level of supervision. On this basis, all of our trips operate on a 1:2 ratio for Reception wherever possible. Other considerations when deciding on numbers of adult helpers include the number of younger siblings attending, as they have to be counted within our ratios, and the number of children who require 1:1 support. For this visit we estimate that we will need 30 helpers for the trip to take place safely and ensure adequate levels of supervision.

Please give your consent on Arbor for your child to attend.
