On our maths table we looked at different sized animals, we were able to put the animals in order small and big, some of us could even point out the medium sized animal. Great work.


In our outside provision, we enjoyed using our balancing skills, as well as our imagination.

We had to walk along a thin piece of wood. Being careful not to fall into the swamp which contained alligators and crocodiles.


