Using our fine motor skills we really enjoyed placing tiny dotty stickers on to a mermaid tail. We created a beautiful pattern.

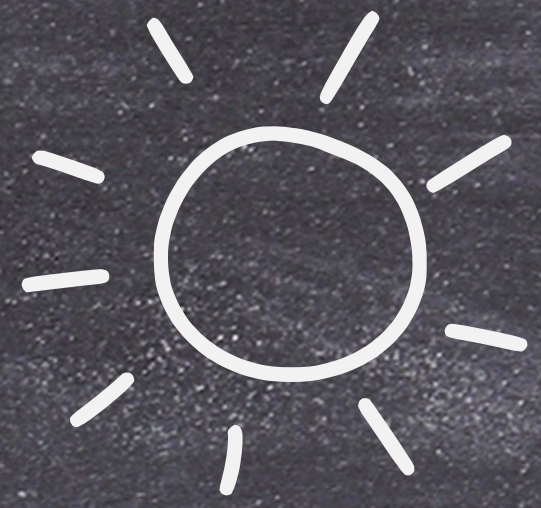

We loved listening to the singing mermaid at chat time, we enjoyed singing nursery rhymes and this week we also enjoyed participating in ring games. Well done.

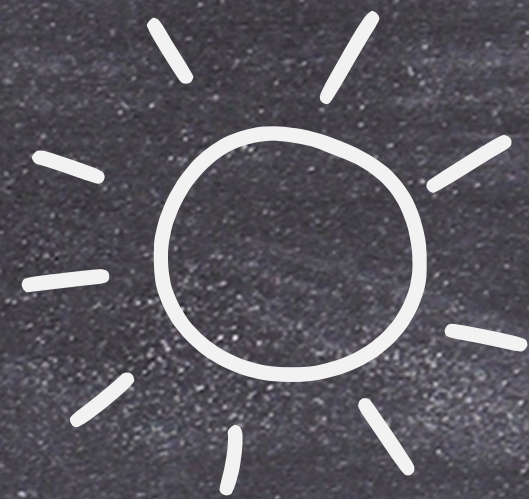
