We've enjoyed potion making with petals and coloured water, using our imagination to think of magical spells. We've also enjoyed playing in seaside and shaving foam tuff trays.

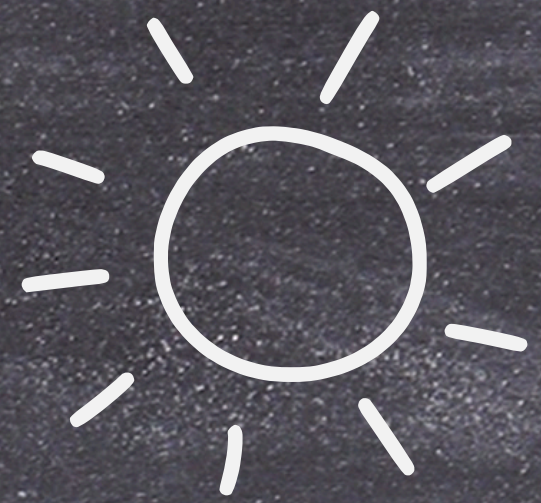

In phonics we have been looking for the rhyming pairs as well as enjoying games like cross the river, tomato ketchup, I spy and Simon says.

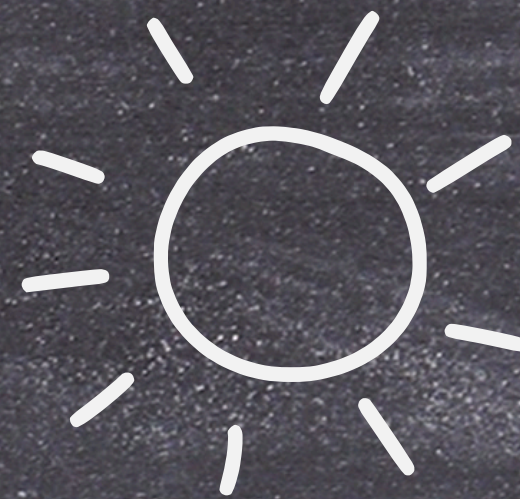
The weeks are going super fast now and we're enjoying lots of play and interactions in provision. Making the most of the children before they move onto their next adventures.
