

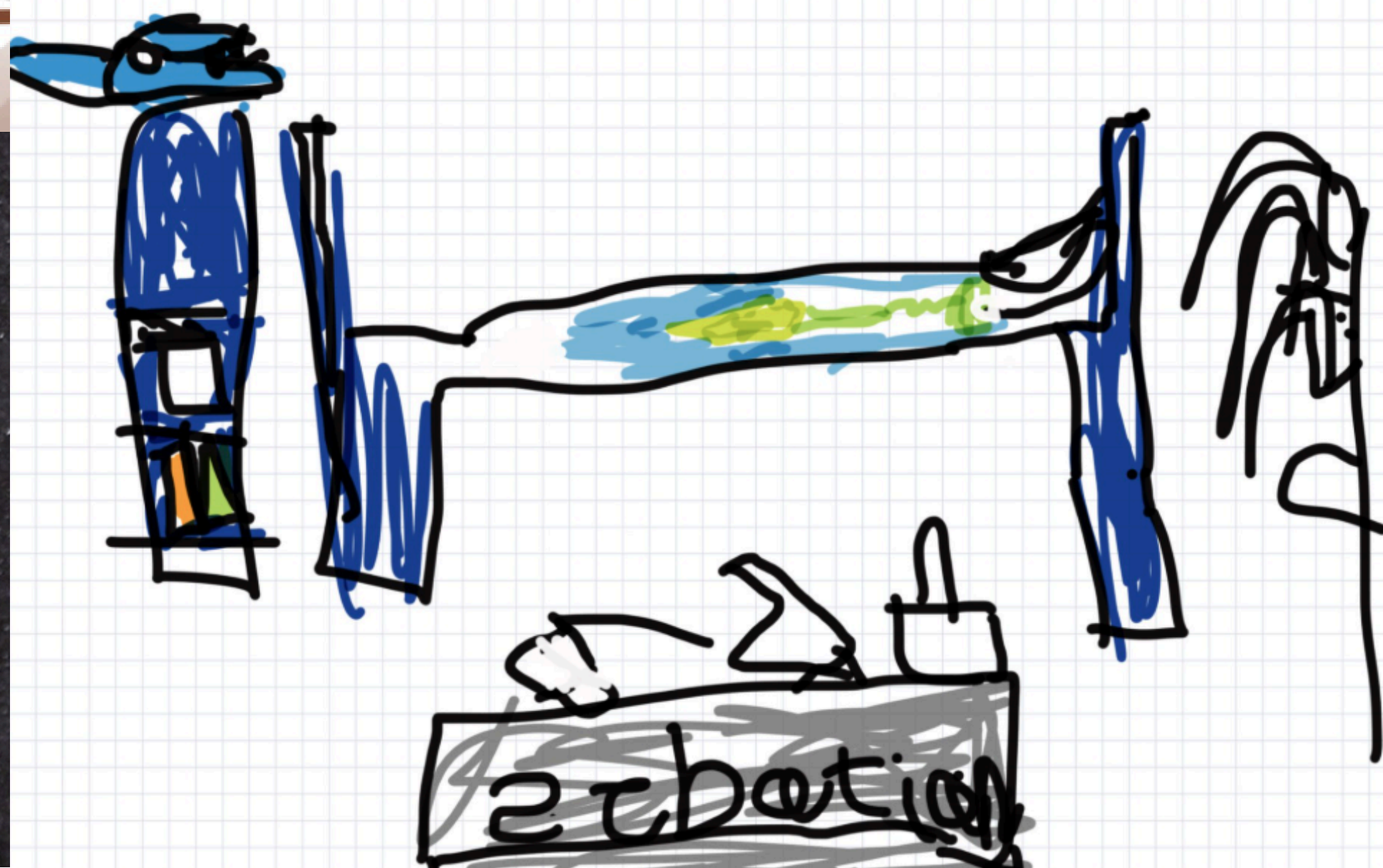
YEAR ONE~ OUR LEARNING SUMMER 1 WEEK 2

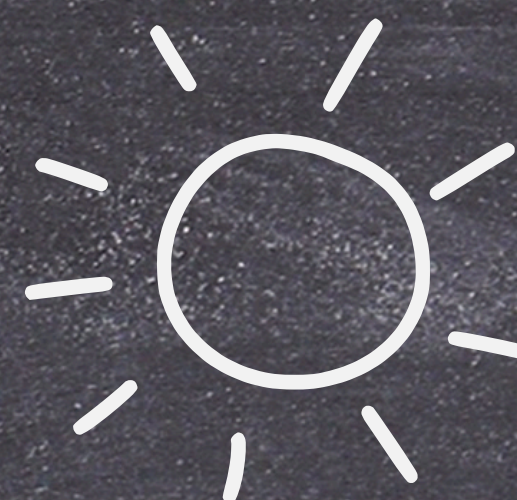

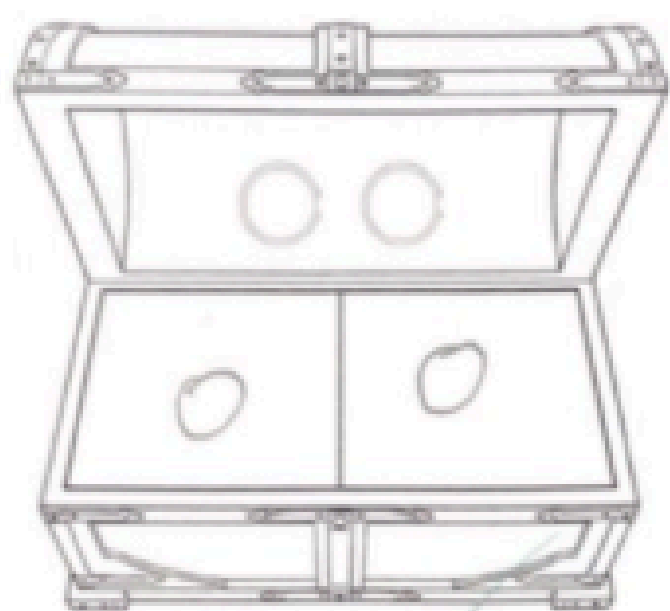




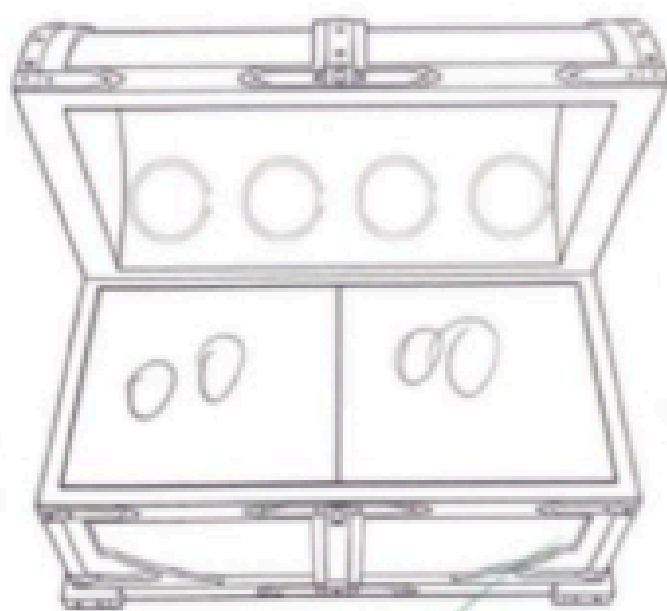

Pirate Halving

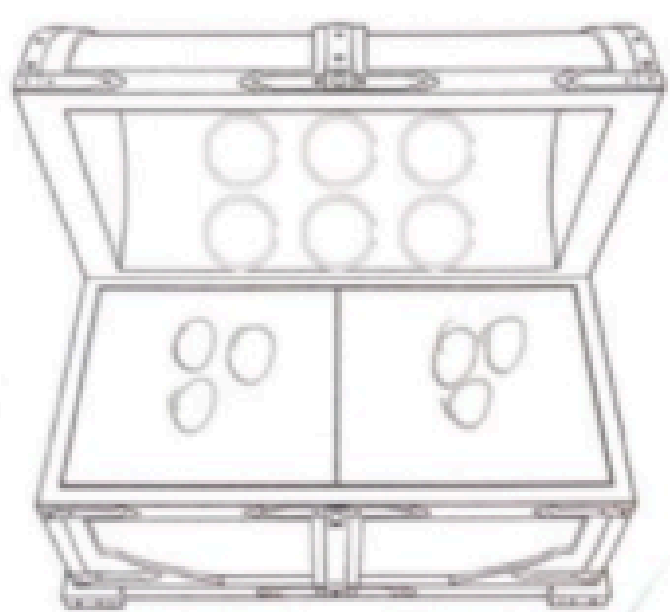
Count the coins above the treasure chest. Then, equally share and draw the coins onto either side of the treasure chest to find half the amount.



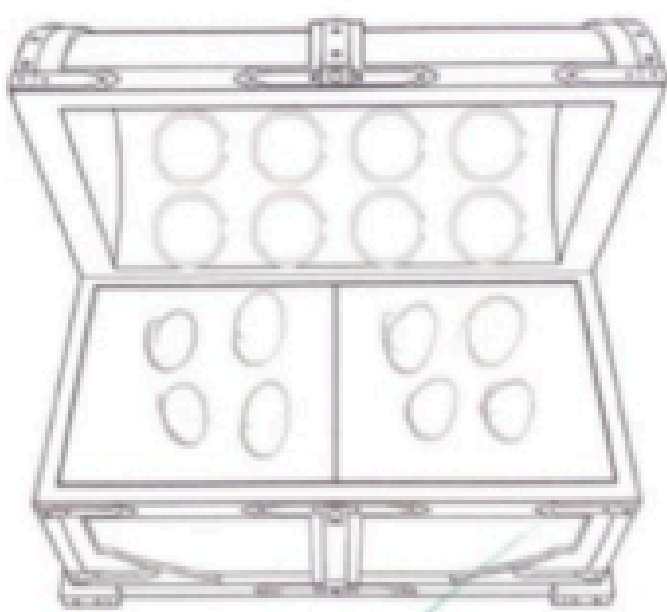
Half of 2 is 2 ✓



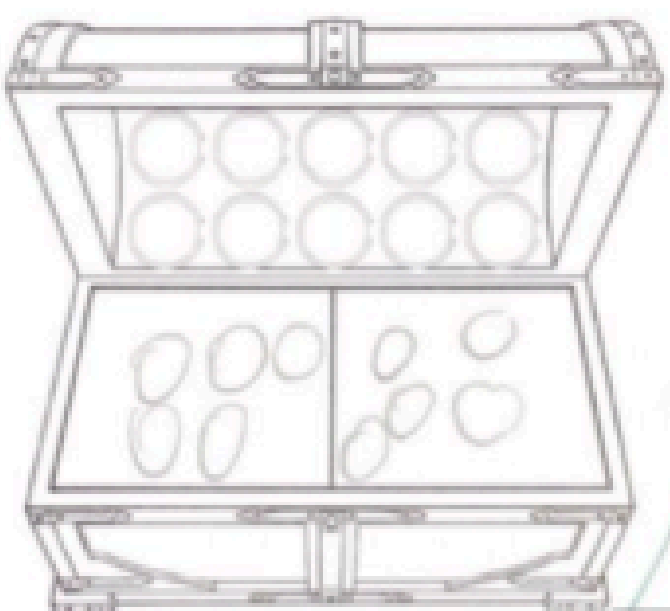
Half of 4 is 2 ✓
