iPads at Home Acceptable Use Policy

We are pleased to offer iPad access for all pupils at Western Primary. Children whose parents have opted into the payment scheme will be allowed to take their iPad home each evening.

By signing this agreement, children are agreeing to the following rules:

- iPads are used for learning- they are never used for playing games unless it is a learning game that your teacher has asked you to play.
- iPads are never to be used in school at break times, lunchtimes, before school or after school.
- We only use our iPads for what we have been asked to use them for.
- If you take your iPad home you must bring it in every day fully charged.
- When your teacher says iPads down, you must put your iPad face down on the table and not fiddle with it.
- AirDrop is only to be used when your teacher asks you to.
- Cameras are only to be used when your teacher asks you to and for tasks that you teacher has asked you to complete.
- Look after your iPad! Do not put it on the floor, run with it or lose it. iPads must go in a bag for carrying home.
- Do not use anyone else's iPad.
- Only use the internet sensibly and appropriately. Remember, teachers can (and will) check your search history at any time.
- Be careful about screen time. Have regular breaks from looking at your screen.
- Always sit up straight at a table to use your iPad. Don't sit hunched over with it on your lap.

I have read Western Primary School's 'Children's Acceptable Use Policy' and understand not following all of the applicable rules will result in the school restricting my iPad use or taking other appropriate action to protect our people, our equipment or our reputation.
